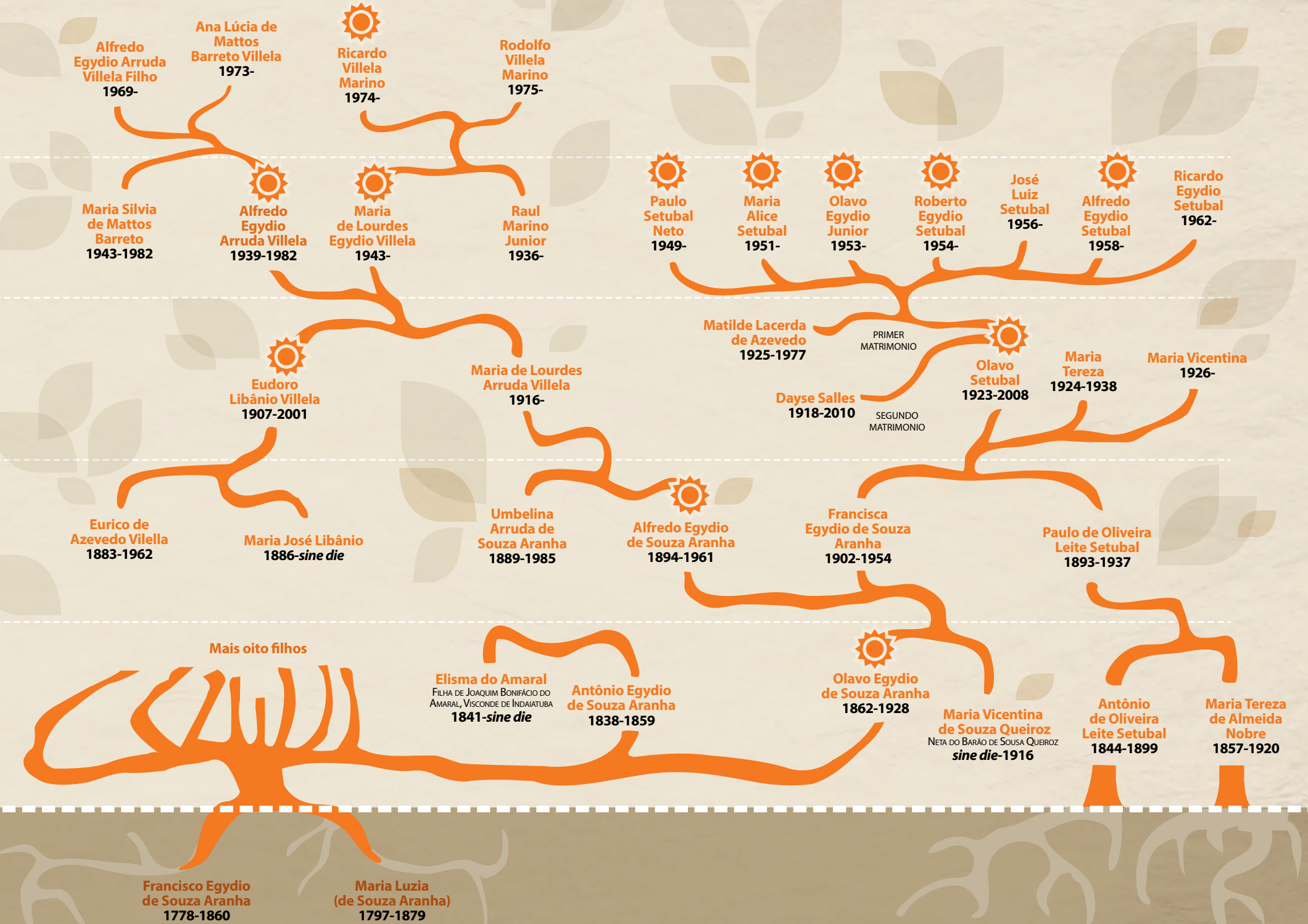
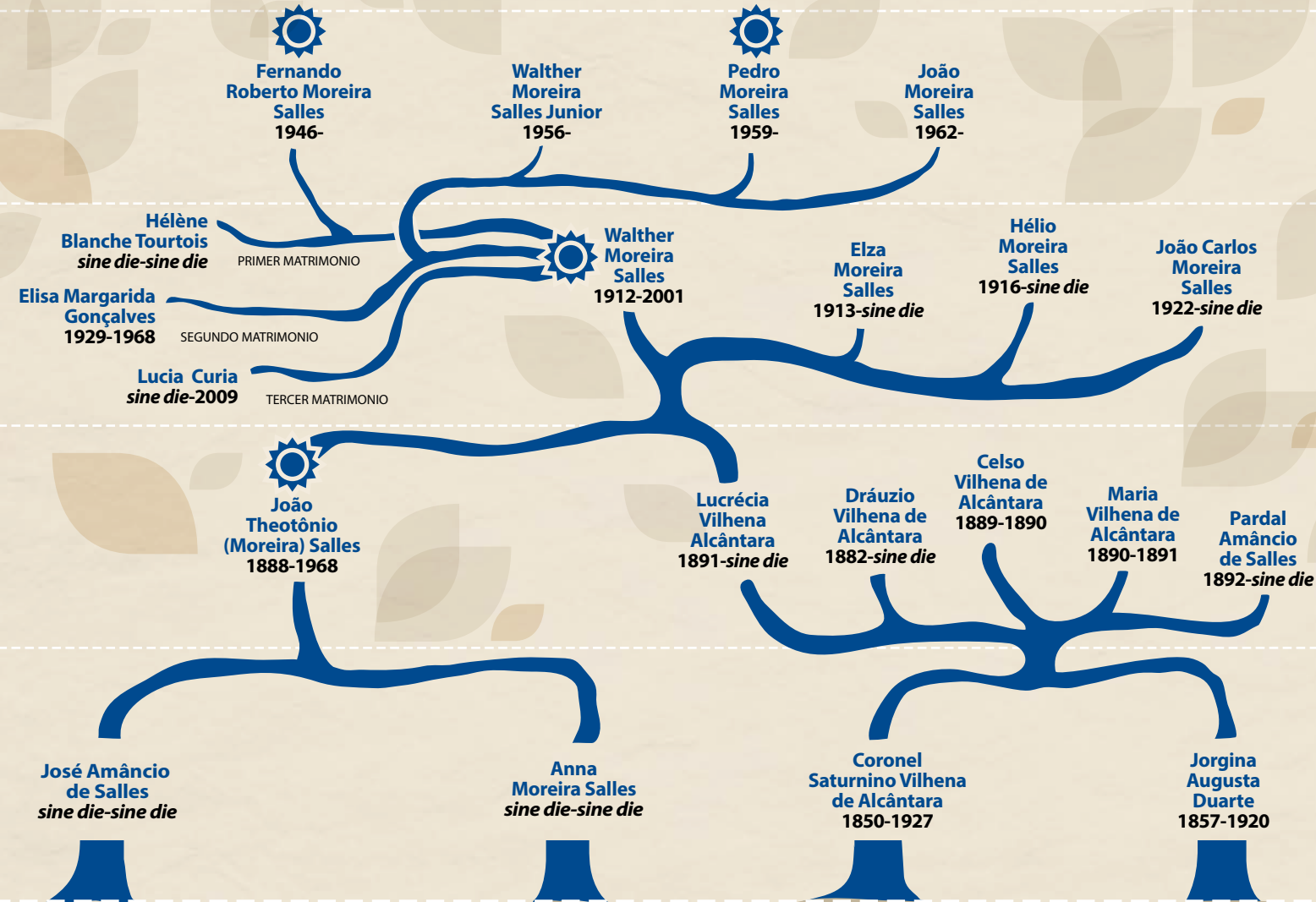

Main characters of Itaú Unibanco's 90 years of history



João Moreira Salles
A child of farmers, he opened Casa Moreira Salles in Poços de Caldas, in 1924. Itaú Unibanco was originated from this commercial establishment.



Walther Moreira Salles
Ambassador and a public figure, he also assumed Casa Bancária Moreira Salles management in 1933 and led its expansion.



Pedro Moreira Salles
A Unibanco mentor for the merger, he is the current chairman of Itaú Unibanco Board of Directors.



Fernando Roberto Moreira Salles
He was vice-chairman of Unibanco Board of Directors in the 1980s. Nowadays he is the chairman of Itaú Unibanco Participações S.A. Board of Directors.



Alfredo Egydio de Souza Aranha
Founder of Banco Central de Crédito, in São Paulo in 1945, an institution that gave rise to Itaú.



Eudoro Villela
A scientist, he was invited to be part of BCC by his father-in-law, Alfredo Egydio, whom he followed as the institution president.



Olavo Setubal
Engineer, he was mayor of São Paulo and a public figure. He chaired Itaú for many decades.



Maria de Lourdes (Milú) Villela
Psychologist, vice-chairman of Itaú S.A. Board, president of Itaú Cultural and São Paulo Museum of Modern Art



Paulo Setubal Neto
He was Itaútec president. A permanent member of Duratex Board and one of the main executives in the company's history.



Olavo Egydio Junior
Executive in Duratex, Itaútec and other companies of the group.



Roberto Egydio Setubal
A Itaú mentor for the merger, he is the current CEO of Itaú Unibanco.



Alfredo Egydio Setubal
Member of Itaú Unibanco Board of Directors. Director of Investor Relations and vice-president of Wealth Management & services.



Alfredo Egydio Arruda Villela Filho
President of Itaú S.A., holding company of Itaú Unibanco group

Itaú Unibanco Vice-President For Latin America.
